COMING SOON: "Building a Super carrier! Andrew Blackburn is the Commander (Air Engineering) of HMS QUEEN ELIZABETH - by some margin the largest ship ever built for the Royal Navy. He approved much of the design, and has overseen the assembly of the Ship in Scotland since 2011. We are planning an evening in which he will discuss why successive governments have invested so much in these vessels; the types of missions they will undertake; the novel way in which they have been built; some of the technological advances; and a sailor's view on what it will be like to serve in them at sea." Caretaker Position for the Tab We are looking for a new caretaker for the Tab. Initially this will be for 3 hours per week at the rate of £10 pounds per hour. General duties will include oversight of church furniture setting needs, programming of heating, waste management, liaison with the fabric panel regarding minor repairs, oversight of site security with the possibility of on call arrangements, and the overseeing of the ordering and delivery of cleaning materials. We need someone who is reliable and honest with an appreciation of the church ethos and the skills required for these tasks. CREDO: I BELIEVE ...

This Autumn and Spring in our adult education we are looking at the topic of Belief. What do we believe as Christians in the Reformed Church? Can we give a reason for the belief we have if someone were to ask us? Many of us have had diverse Christian backgrounds and church experiences: what are the Reformed faith and its special emphasis?

There is an opportunity to discuss some of these issues in small house groups. These give an opportunity to meet with others for friendship, laughter, discussion and encouraging each other in our faith. Most of the groups are looking at Christian Belief this autumn: helping us discover what we believe in the Reformed Church. The course is called 'Credo: I believe...'
